



Notice on COVID-19 Vaccination For children between 6 months and 4 years (Infants and young children)



Parents/guardians, please read this with your child before they receive the vaccine.

To the parent/guardian

Once you have read and understood the enclosed explanatory vaccine flyer and leaflet entitled "Notice on COVID-19 Vaccination" from the Ministry of Health, Labour and Welfare with your child, please consult with your primary medical physician and talk with your child before deciding on the vaccination.

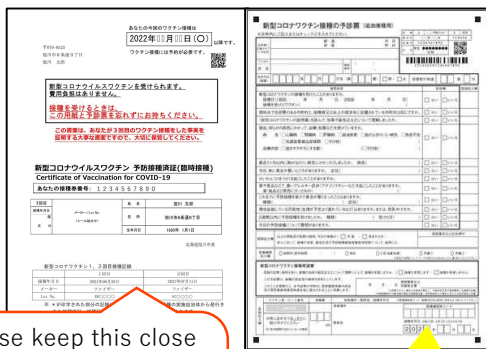
COVID-19 Vaccination is not compulsory. Those who are vaccinated should understand both the effectiveness of vaccination in preventing infectious diseases and their risk of adverse reactions, and receive the vaccination voluntarily. No vaccination will be given without the consent of the parent.

About the Vaccination Certificate and Pre-vaccination Questionnaire/Vaccination Voucher

Vaccinations for infants and young children come in sets of 3 doses.

The vaccination certificate, the pre-vaccination screening questionnaire, and the vaccination voucher are printed on the two forms shown below.

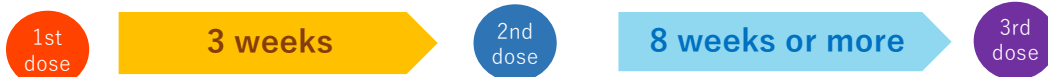

About the vaccines being used

Pfizer Vaccine for infants



For those who turned 5 between their 1st and 2nd doses, between their 2nd and 3rd dose, use Pfizer vaccine for infants for their 2nd dose and 3rd dose.

If your child turned 5 before their 1st dose, use a vaccine for ages 5 and above. You can use the vaccination voucher you received with this notice.



How to get the vaccine:

For those with a primary care physician, please send all enquiries to each medical institution. Please remember to tell them the child's age and date of birth when you set up your appointment.

Call each medical institution directly to set up an appointment

Although it is generally recommended that those who have previously been infected with COVID-19 be vaccinated 90 days after treatment, we ask that you first consult your primary medical physician.

Your consent is required to receive the vaccine

While we recommend that all Asahikawa residents receive the COVID-19 vaccine, it is not mandatory to do so. We will only administer the vaccine to those who have been provided with proper information about both the benefits and risk of side effects of immunization and who have consented of their own free will to be vaccinated. However, we require as a rule that a parent, guardian or caretaker provide their signature on the pre-vaccination questionnaire and accompany the child. We will not administer the vaccine without the parent/guardian's consent. The child will be unable to receive the vaccine if there is no signature on the form.

We ask that you not force those around you or at school to receive the vaccine, and that you not discriminate against those who have not received the vaccine.

About Underlying Conditions

Please consult your primary care physician first if you have any underlying medical conditions. For more on underlying conditions, please refer to the Asahikawa City Homepage.

Relief System for Injury to Health with Vaccination

There have been cases of damage to health (such as falling ill or acquiring a disability) as a result of vaccination. While such cases are extremely rare, a relief system has been set up for those who sustain permanent health damages. For more about the steps necessary to apply, please consult the Asahikawa Public Health Center's Measures for Novel Coronavirus Infection Control Division.

Other items of importance

○For those who wish to receive the vaccine outside of Asahikawa (Vaccination outside of registered city)

If you have a certificate of residence registered with Asahikawa but you are living in a different municipality, by notifying them, you may be able to receive the vaccine in the area you actually live. Please visit your municipality's town/city ahll for more information.

○For those who have moved out of Asahikawa

If you have moved out, you cannot use Asahikawa's vaccination voucher. Please go to the city/town hall of the municipality you have moved to in order to be issued another voucher. You are also required to bring the previously issued one from Asahikawa, so please do not dispose of it.
